## Montessori Parent-Child Class: Six Week Session

Please join us for a parent-child class in the Young Children's Community facilitated by Ms. Laura, our Montessori-trained Assistants to Infancy (0-3 yrs old) guide.

This class is an opportunity for your child to work with Montessori materials designed for your child's age and skill level. Parents will explore the environment with their child, observe their child working on his or her own, and observe Montessori presentations given by the guide to their child.

We will begin each class with a short parent discussion to acquaint everyone with the content and discuss guidelines for time spent in the Young Children's Community. The children will then have time to work in the environment at their own pace and according to their interests. There will be time for parents to connect and discuss after this as the children play in the yard. Weekly reading materials are provided for your reference and discussions center on topics such as the Montessori approach to toileting, communication, movement, independence, and self-discipline.
